Re: IELTS and School Support Measures (S5)

International English Language Testing System, IELTS, is a widely recognized English Language test for students, especially for those who require to use English Language for communication in their study at local or overseas universities. S5 and S6 Students who have taken the IELTS would not only know their own English proficiency level but also be able to plan their study well before the release of the HKDSE results. The result of the IELTS would remain valid for two years. HKEAA has once published a research on the correlation of HKDSE English Language and IELTS in 2012.
