2. Performances

3. Rewards and punishments

Members demonstrating good attitudes will receive a <u>merit</u> and earn a maximum of <u>10 bonus</u> <u>marks</u> in their year-end music examination at school.

Members who are frequently late to or absent from rehearsals or who cannot attend the dress rehearsal will not be given any credit. If the conductor feels that there is a problem, whether it is related to weekly musical preparations or to behaviour, it will be discussed first with the member. If there is no improvement, the teacher advisor will contact the parents and may remove the member from further participation in the orchestra.

4. Etiquettes

A strong instrumental programme relies on the combined efforts and mutual cooperation of its members. During rehearsals and performances, members are expected to:

- > arrive on time,
- respect and listen to the conductor and teacher advisor,
- refrain from unnecessary talking or other disruptive behaviour, and
- > refrain from using mobile phones.

Before each rehearsal, members are expected to practise their parts as requested. If a member would like to be excused from a rehearsal, he should **submit a parent's letter to the teacher advisor in person**. An unexcused absence from a dress rehearsal will prevent the member from participating in that performance.

All music parts are rearranged to best suit the number and level of members in each section. It is irresponsible of any member to be absent from any Friday rehearsals for poor time management.
