## Re: HKDSE Music – 2021–2024 Network school programme

To enhance the teaching and learning of HKDSE Music, the school has entered a partnership with St. Joseph's College. Students participating in the programme may eventually have the chance to sit in the 2024 HKDSE – Music upon satisfactory performance as determined by teachers from both schools. Details of the programme are stipulated below:

#### 1. Curriculum details

Core parts of the curriculum will be covered in this programme (i.e. Compulsory Module 1 (Listening), Module 2 (Performing I) and Module 3 (Creating I)). Students participating in the programme will take the following elective: Module 5 (Performing II).

### 2. Lesson arrangements

Date: every Thursday (exact dates to be confirmed) Time: 4:30-7:00 p.m. (during normal school days)

Venue: Music Room, St. Joseph's College

Instructor: Mr. Chris Cheng (Music panel head of St. Joseph's College)

In case of leave (with doctor's certificate for sick leave), letters should be addressed to the Principal with parent's signature.

Students should dress in proper school uniform on school days.

#### 3. Expectations

Students are expected to complete all assignments and submit them on time as required by the instructor.

Examinations are held at the end of each term. Students must complete all assessments set by the programme instructors. Non-participation without valid reasons would imply termination of the student's enrolment in the programme. Continuation of the programme is stipulated upon satisfactory performance in both lesson time and assessments, as well as achieving an attendance rate of 90% or above.

Should the student's performance be deemed below standard, he may be required to withdraw from the programme. The school would not enter him in the HKDSE examination for this subject.

#### 4. Dropping of elective subjects

Participation in this programme does not count as an HKDSE elective offered by the school. Therefore, following the school-wide policy, students participating in this programme may not drop any electives until after the Mid-year exam in S5. There must be a minimum of <u>TWO</u> electives taken in St. Louis School, i.e. only <u>ONE</u> elective scheduled on the timetable can be dropped.
