### Re: S1 English Enhancement Programme

We are delighted to welcome your child to our big family!

St. Louis School is a traditional English-medium Catholic boys' school run by Society of St. Francis de Sales. To optimize our students' exposure to English Language, the school is committed to tapping additional resources so as to help students adapt to an all-round English Learning environment as a newcomer. To this end, we are going to organize an after-school English Enhancement Programme for all S1 students.

This programme serves the purpose of helping your child fortify a solid foundation of English Language through incorporating language art activities after school and offering practices to prepare them to sit for a recognized English proficiency test called "Preliminary English Test for School (PETfS)" to be held on 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2023 (Sat) at school. PETfS is one of the many Cambridge English tests designed for young English learners who are striving to upgrade their English proficiency.

To give students a taste of language art activities, we are going to arrange a drama show and a drama workshop, in collaboration with our NET, in the first term. Further details will be revealed in due course.
