Re: St. Louis School Badminton Team Practice Arrangement 2022-23

We are glad to invite your son to become a member of the school badminton team who will be representing our school to participate in the inter-school badminton competition if he demonstrates good skills, physical ability, discipline and attitude during the school year.

Here are the details of the team regular training:

Time: 2 p.m. – 4 p.m. (Every Tuesday and Thursday)

Venue: To be confirmed (Priority will be given to Smithfield Sports Centre, Shek Tong Tsui Sports Centre and Aberdeen Sports Centre)

Remarks: In order to comply with the requirements stipulated in the Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions) (Business and Premises) Regulation (Cap. 599F) and relevant requirements of administrative instructions, users of sports premises **are required to scan the "LeaveHomeSafe" QR code** before being allowed to enter for necessary contact tracing if a confirmed case is found. In accordance with the Prevention and Control of Disease (Vaccine Pass) Regulation (Cap. 599L) and relevant requirements of administrative instructions, all persons entering or remaining at sports premises or other indoor venues under the management of the LCSD **must comply with the requirement of the Vaccine Pass.**

Students should arrive at the sports centre 5 minutes earlier for warm-up and they will dismiss at the sports centre after the training

Fee: \$600 per year (Fee collected will be used for purchasing shuttlecocks, salary of coach and court rental). Please pay by cheque payable to “**The IMC of St. Louis School**” or “**聖類斯中學法團校董會**” to the teacher advisor on or before 16th September. **Students should write their name, class and class number on the back of the cheque.** Students with financial difficulties may seek school subsidy upon written request.

Training is compulsory for all team members. To ensure the building of team work and develop the sense of responsibility, your son should inform the teacher advisor or the coach at least 1 day in advance if he, for any reasons, cannot attend the training. Failure to do so will result in a verbal warning, a ban from joining any competitions or even expulsion from the team. **Team members who have outstanding performance and/ or attendance will be rewarded a light merit or minor merit by the end of the term.** Any enquiries can be directed to the teacher advisor, Ms CHAN Man Ying at 25460117.
