Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: S3 TSA Mock Assessment Results

Thank you for reading this notice concerning the results your son obtained in the TSA Mock Assessment held in late March to help his teacher gauge if he has achieved the basic competence in the 3 papers (Writing, Reading and Speaking) as required by the EDB before he finishes his S.3 studies. Since we used past assessment papers and marking schemes, the results of your son can best reflect his present standard.

While you may refer to your son for his actual assessment results, I would like to inform you that your son should attend several lessons after school before the final examination in June. Given his results, it is deemed that the school should take some remedial measures in order to equip your son with more knowledge of the paper(s) he has been found being weak in. We hope that through this remedy, he can eventually take the territory-wide TSA assessments on 14th and 15th June more competently.

Please note that the above remedy has been agreed on by all teachers of English who therefore would appreciate it if you and your son could take this matter seriously because every student's results count towards the school status as an EMI school for being successful or not in helping her students attain the basic English standard before he completes S.3. Hence allow me to ask you for a favour: kindly try to understand the reasons for your son's results and impress on him the importance of attending these tutorials for the ultimate benefit and reputation of the school and him. Also, please kindly understand that it is our duty to contact you in case your son fails to come to the scheduled tutorials.

As an incentive to your son: please note that when your son can score a satisfactory mark in the first two practices, he needs not come for the last one, and the higher score will replace the low one he obtained earlier for the yearly assignment mark which appears on the report card.

It is our sincere belief that as long as your son is committed to this TSA, he will eventually make the grade and perform very well in the actual assessments in June.
