4. Rewards and Punishments

5. Attire

For rehearsals except performance day:

For performance day:

- Winter school uniform (i.e. long-sleeved shirt, school tie)
- School blazer
- Black leather shoes

6. Etiquette

Participation in rehearsals is **compulsory** starting from the date when students complete all internal examinations at school.

During rehearsals and the performance, members are expected to:

- arrive on time,
- respect and listen to the conductor and teacher advisor,
- refrain from unnecessary talking or other disruptive behaviour, and
- refrain from using mobile phones.

Before each rehearsal, members are expected to practise their parts as requested. This is of the utmost importance as both our school and the organiser expect members to perform at a high standard. Recordings of playing that demonstrate members' proficiency may be required by the teacher advisor or conductor to ensure a high level of playing among all members.
