Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Re: St. Louis School Badminton Team Practice 2023-24

We are so glad to inform you that your son has been selected as the member of the school badminton team who will be representing our school to participate in the inter-school badminton competition if he demonstrates good skills, physical ability and discipline during the school year.

Here are the details of the team training:

Time: 4 p.m. – 6 p.m. (September-April),

Every Tuesday and Thursday (There will be no training on which school special events, holidays or examination weeks are held.)

Venue: To be confirmed (Priority will be given to Ap Lei Chau Sports Centre, Wong Chuk Hang Sports Centre and Shek Tong Tsui Sports Centre)

Temporary scheduled training days are listed below (A total of 40 lessons excluding summer holiday. Time and venues depending on the availability of public badminton courts):

Fee: \$1000 per year (Fee collected will be used for purchasing shuttlecocks, salary of coach and court rental). Please pay by cheque payable to “**The IMC of St. Louis School**” or “**聖類斯中學法團校董會**” to the teacher advisor on or before 22nd September. **Students should write their name, class and class number on the back of the cheque.** Students with financial difficulties may seek school subsidy upon written request.

Remarks: Students should arrive at the sports centre themselves 10 minutes earlier for warm-up and they will dismiss at the sports centre after the training.

Training is compulsory for all team members. To ensure the building of team work and develop the sense of responsibility, your son should inform the teacher advisor or the coach at least 1 day in advance if he, for any reasons, cannot attend the training. Failure to do so will result in a verbal warning, a ban from joining any competitions or even expulsion from the team. **Team members who have outstanding performance and/ or attendance will be rewarded a light merit or minor merit by the end of the term.** Any enquiries can be directed to the teacher advisor, Ms CHAN Man Ying at 25460117.
