RE: Disciplinary Matters Regarding Demerit and Demerit Voidance

- 1. The academic reports (term 1 and annual) will show the <u>TOTAL</u> number of merits and demerits given throughout the first term and the scholastic year 2024-2025 respectively. Voided demerits will <u>NOT</u> be shown.
- 2. The deadline for demerit voidance is 4th December, 2024 (Day 5). The number of demerits that are not voided on or before the above date will be shown on the term 1 academic report.
- **3.** Requirements of voidance
