



Dear Parents/Guardians,

In order to help students catch up with the required work and prepare for examinations, remedial lessons will be organized for S5 students. Our target students are those who did not obtain satisfactory S4 final examination results in Chemistry. Each student will attend 5 remedial lessons in the first school term. For these 5 lessons, your son will be given a useful learning package costing \$830. He can watch the well-prepared explanatory videos of the learning package at his own pace using iPads with his own wireless **Bluetooth earphones**. Then, your son is required to complete the given task and submit it to the online learning and assessment platform for the tutor's marking of each lesson and the inspection of his subject teacher after each lesson.

We hope that by providing students with such extra learning opportunities, they can establish a stronger foundation. As this is a program especially provided to help students attain better results in their DSE Chemistry examination through the use of an additional resource, we strongly recommend that your son attend all the lessons. We will also contact you each time if your son is absent from the course without prior notice and acceptable reasons. Your son may also be charged for the learning package if he fails to achieve 80% attendance.
