Dear Teachers, Parents/Guardians and Students of S3,

Re: Instructions for Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA)

The following are instructions for the Territory-wide School Assessment (TSA) on **Wednesday, 17 June 2026** and **Thursday, 18 June 2026**.

- (1) All students should return to their respective classrooms before 8:10 am.
- (2) Please bring HB pencils, erasers and blue (or black) ball pens on the days of the assessments.
- (3) An public announcements to be made by the Education Bureau regarding the closure of schools and cancellation or postponement of the assessments due to bad weather will be broadcast through radio and television. In case of doubt about the cancellation or postponement of the assessments, all parents and students should pay attention to the public announcement right up to the time they leave for the school. If secondary schools are to be closed in the morning on either of the two days, the assessments will be rescheduled to **Wednesday, 24 June 2026** with the test times remaining unchanged, and all Secondary 3 students will then have to come back on that day.
